## Warrigal Op Shop committed to reducing landfill

The Warrigal Op Shop is located on George Street, Warilla and open Wednesday to Friday, 9.30am to 2.00pm.

The Op Shop is operated by the Warrigal Care Auxiliary volunteers and has been proudly serving the local community for over 39 years. All profits go back into purchasing equipment, furniture, acitivites, etc that will directly benefit our residents and assist the staff.

Our volunteers Jenny (Supervisor), Sonya, Susan, Shirley, Johanne, Debbie, Donna, Tia, Pat, Dennese, Julie and Anna are committed to reducing landfill and will recycle items unsuitable for resale. "We hardly put anything in the bin anymore, as it all gets recycled" Jenny said.

A local farmer picks up all the textiles that are unable to be sold and deliveries them to local farmers in the Illawarra and Highlands to be used as rags.

A car detailer in Bulli purchases all flannelette materials to use as polishing rags for his business.

Sonya and Julie (Volunteers) collect bits and pieces from items that can't be sold. Sonya makes Fiddle Mats for our residents living with dementia and Julie make unique broaches and earrings. Julie will also mend clothing e.g., hemming and sewing buttons on to ensure all garments are ready for sale.

Our volunteers take great pride in the Op Shop and are always warm and welcoming, engaging and bring a smile to anyone who visits. "We have so many customers each day, our regular locals, customers across the Illawarra and customers visiting from out of the region who have heard about the shop".

"Our new Fijian staff have become regular visitors at the Shop. They are absolutely delightful and we love having a good laugh with them when they visit after work".

# COVID-19 changes to protocols

Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases, the following protocols will be implemented immediately:

- All staff, visitors, volunteers and contractors must complete a Rapid Antigen Test DAILY when entering the care home.
- Surgical masks can continue to be worn in the home if it is not experiencing an outbreak.
- Anyone going into an area of the home where there are positive cases, must wear an N95 mask and eye protection. Other areas within the home do not have positive cases, do not require eye protection, but an N95 mask must be worn.

These protocols will be reviewed at the end of the year.
