Accommodation Pricing

Option 1: Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) The maximum lump sum payment is \$489,000.

Option 2: Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP). The maximum payment is \$111.73 per day

Option 3: RAD + DAP Combined. This is a combination payment that is made up of part Refundable Accommodation Deposit, and part Daily Accommodation payment. In this case you can deduct the daily payment (DAP) from the lump sum payment (RAD).

You are able to pay any RAD + DAP combination you wish.

For example a lump sum payment of **\$250,000 + \$54.60 per day**



Accommodation room description

A single ensuite room with well appointed fixtures and fittings. Natural light streams in through large mid-floor to ceiling windows, dressed with colour coordinated Holland blinds, that are easily maneuvered to ensure privacy. Round ceiling lights illuminate well maintained, colour- coordinated interiors with flooring in modern vinyl.

Comfortable high/low adjustable beds come with linens and pressure-relieving mattresses are available if required. Complete with single wardrobes with hanging space and drawers, a bedside table, an over bed table and visitor chairs. There are nurse call points, and access for a landline telephone.

Rooms can be kept at a comfortable temperature all year round with a combination of central heating in common areas and some rooms with wall or ceiling fans.
