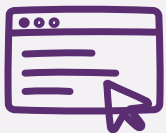


Submitting feedback to Warrigal

Feedback

On the Warrigal website, select Feedback in the footer to open the feedback page, where you can lodge your form.

The three kinds of feedback

Complaint

A concern that needs to be raised

Suggestion

A recommendation to improve our services

Compliment

Positive feedback

Filling in the form

- 1 Site or service.** Choose the location your feedback relates to.
- 2 Type.** Choose compliment, complaint or improvement suggestion.
- 3 Subject title.** A short heading for your feedback, for example, *Fantastic customer service*.
- 4 Date.** Today's date fills in for you. Pick an earlier date if you need to.
- 5 Details.** Tell us what happened, when it happened and who was involved. The more detail you give, the better we can act on it.
- 6 Your name.** Add your name, or leave the box blank to stay anonymous.
- 7 Your email.** Add an email address if you would like us to write back.
- 8 Your phone number.** Add a number if you would rather we called you.
- 9 Submit.** When the form is complete, select Submit at the top right of the page.
- 10 Confirmation.** The page refreshes to confirm your feedback has been sent. Select Submit new feedback to lodge another, or close the window.



Your details are up to you. Your name and contact details are voluntary. If you share them, we can come back to you with a response.
